All participants must be members of the Alberta Equestrian Federation. Please include your AEF number on your entry form. Be sure to sign the Acknowledgement of Risk and Liability Waiver. ***** Note***** There are **two** different forms to be signed, one for Juniors and one for Seniors. Make sure you sign the right one. The Juniors form **must be signed by the parent or legal guardian. Coaches are not to sign in proxy.**

Before mailing have you included: Completed entry form with cheque to cover all fees with a separate stall cleaning deposit cheque. Correct Acknowledgement of Risk and Liability Waiver.

Rules and Regulations

This show will be run under the rules of the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of Canada with the following local rules in place.

Show time 8:00 AM Saturday and 9:00 AM Sunday.

Age of exhibitor is their age as of December 31, 2008. Juniors are 10 and under, 8-12 years, and 13-17 years. Seniors are 18 years and over. Riders in the 7 and under – lead line, or 10 and under- walk/trot, divisions may not cross enter any other division except costume and lead only Trail.

Open means, open to any animal; mares, geldings, or stallions.

Juniors 16 years of age and older may show stallions in-hand only. No juniors to ride or drive stallions.

Championships will not be awarded for classes with 2 or fewer ponies.

Any animal entering a stake class MUST have entered at least one other class in that division.

To qualify for National points in Hunter Under Saddle, please see High Point Rules at www.welshponyandcob.org/highpointrules.html.

No animal may be left in the hitching ring without the express permission of the gate person. The gate person, ringmaster or Steward may request that any pony wait outside the hitching ring, for any reason.

Walk **ONLY** in the hitching ring.

All animals, with the exception of Registered pony breeds with a breed standard that permits over 14.2 (i.e. Welsh Pony & Cob, Connemara, Fjord, etc.), must be 14.2 hands or under.

All registered animals must be entered under their registered names, and listed under the registered owner or lessee.

Registration papers or copies of registration papers must be made available to the show committee on demand. In case of dispute, the animal in question may not be shown until the registration papers have been examined by the show committee, and found to be correct.

The Show committee and/or ground jury reserve the right to correct any error or make any alterations to the rules or prize list. Classes may be combined, split or cancelled at the committee's discretion.

The show committee will be wearing orange vests. At least one show committee member will be available at all times to answer questions.

The show committee reserves the right to refuse entry for any reason.

The show committee reserves the right to remove any owner, rider, driver, groom, exhibitor, or pony from the show and/or show-grounds for any act of discourtesy or disobedience, without any liability for compensation whatsoever.

The ringmaster or steward may excuse any unruly pony from the ring without the show or anyone connected with the show being liable for any compensation whatsoever. This rule is mandatory for Junior riders as per SR300.3 of the WPCSC rule book. "Unruly ponies" includes ponies which repeatedly interfere with the forward motion of other competitors.

No person other than the officials, attendants on duty and the judge, may enter the show ring without permission. No parents and/or trainers to be in the ring with the exception of Lead Line, Showmanship 7 and under, or Costume class.

Gate holds are two minutes only, after which time the gate will be closed. This limit will be strictly adhered to. Gate holds must be requested from the gate person.

Tack changes may be done at the gate.

All juniors must wear an ASTM approved helmet with the chin strap secured, at all times while mounted or showing on the show grounds. Seniors wearing helmets must have chinstraps secured while mounted. ASTM approved helmets with secured chin straps are required FOR ALL RIDERS over fences.

All ponies shown in performance classes must be 3 years or older.

Protests must be received, in writing, by the show committee within 24 hours of the class, accompanied by a \$50.00 deposit. The deposit is forfeited if the protest is not sustained.

Removing the bridle from any animal still hitched to a vehicle will result in instant elimination.

All Juniors aged 14 and under MUST at all times have an adult capable of rendering assistance with them while driving.
